Welcome to our award winning regenerative eco-farm, offering a tranquil location for your event.

If you are planning a meeting, conference, or other corporate event it can be a challenge to find a venue which meets all your needs, and doesn't feel like being back in the office. At Fernhill Farm we offer a relaxed alternative venue in beautiful surroundings, with plenty of space for thinking outside the box.

Fernhill Farm is situated in the middle of the historic Natural Landscape, a designated Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty (AONB) on the Mendip Hills in the South West of England. Located just 15 miles from the city of Bristol, 10 miles from Bristol Airport and 20 miles from Bath. Fernhill is easily accessible.

It's an all-grassland farm with orchards, woodlands, hedges, and limestone walls that create a diverse range of field boundaries, making this a safe haven for both livestock and wildlife. Renewable energy installations ensure we can offer a carbon-conscious experience.

Here is some information on the buildings eco credentials:

- Underfloor heating throughout from homegrown logs and willow used to fuel our 170 kw log boiler.
- The central heating system is topped up by hot water from the sun by our solar thermal heating system.
- Rain water is harvested from roofs to flush toilets and supply chlorine-free grey water to the poly tunnel and livestock drinking troughs.
- All waste water is pumped to the on-site chemical-free water purification system known as the Water Ecological Treatment (WET) system.
- The WET system grows willow wands for weaving, kindling and firewood and is a British Crayfish Conservation Site

With a large main conference hall, suited to large meetings and presentations of up to 100 people, the space can also be set up for smaller groupings around tables. There are three additional and adaptable break out spaces. A large dining area, covered outdoor spaces, and hard-track access to outdoor courtyard and fields. We can also offer outside seating arrangements with stunning views of the Mendip countryside. Fernhill Farm is real and rustic whilst offering a unique and secluded venue for day and residential meetings, conferences, team-building activities, training days and corporate events.

Hive Hall

Situated inside The Horseshoe Barns, a 17th Century Grade II listed cow shed in a semi-circular design now refurbished into a unique venue for a variety of uses. These Eco Barns are furnished with rustic charm, utilising reclaimed timbers, home-grown wood from the farm and wool insulation. There is a wholesome blend of natural materials to create a homely space for your group to escape the rigours of everyday life.



Wren Cottage (Breakout space 1)

Wren cottage is so named as it is where the wrens would nest before the barns were brought back from their previous dereliction. Decked out in typical Fernhill Farm style with wool and reclaimed wood furnishings, this is a perfect den for a breakout space for up to 8 people. It can be set with either a formal office table and chairs or informal seating.





The Bar (Break out Space 2)

A cosy seating area that can be set with table and chairs or left as a sofa area depending on your needs.





The Dining Room - Break out Space 3 or Dinning Room.

A Large dining space that can also be designed as a breakout space or medium sized conference room for up to 40 people.

Fernhill Farm is situated on the mendips, off the B3134 near to the Castle of Comfort pub. Or a short drive up from Compton Martin.

From Bristol:

Take the A37 south and go through Pensford. At the roundabout, turn right onto the A368 towards Bishops Sutton. Continue past Chew Valley Lake to West Harp tree village. Approx half a mile after West Harptree turn left up Harptree Hill. At the top turn right onto Evergreen lane and then take the first right onto Ewe Lane. The Farm entrance is on the right after a mile.

There is ample parking on arrival.

From Bath:

Take the A39 through Newton St Loe, taking the second exit (past The Globe pub). Continue straight through Marksbury and continue onto the A368 (the right hand side of the petrol station after the traffic lights). At the roundabout, take the second exit towards Bishop Sutton. After Bishops Sutton continue past Chew Valley Lake to West Harp tree village. Approx half a mile after West Harptree turn left up Harptree Hill. At the top turn right onto Evergreen lane and then take the first right onto Ewe Lane. The Farm entrance is on the right after a mile.
